2006 STRATEGIC FOCUSES**DEVELOPING LEADERS**

- Identify national directors for two new countries and launch first class.
- Establish the prototype for financial sustainability to be implemented in each new partnership across Asia.

MULTIPLYING CONGREGATIONS

- Implement in each country a tracking method for the ministry's four desired outcomes.

NETWORKING

- Initiate research on organizations known for expertise in Asia.

FUNDING THE MINISTRY

- Achieve \$1.9 million in investments through Development activities.
- Develop a list of 50 new potential major investors (≥ \$5,000 annually) through input from current investors, contacts with friends of Asian Access, and research.

SERVING PEOPLE, BUILDING CAPACITY

- Implement internet accessible information dashboards for staff, missionaries and other constituencies.
- Implement upgraded investor tracking and accounting software.

- Produce a high quality Asian Access DVD.
